Confidence Research

You feel confident when life meets your expectations.

"Everything went according to plan. I feel confident!"

You lose confidence when life doesn't meet expectations.

"This shouldn't be happening! What is wrong with me?"

Second Guessing:

"I don't like making decisions

Regrets:

"I struggle with letting things go"

Analyze Until Overwhelmed:

"I can't stop worrying. I'm exhausted!"

Overthinking

Perfectionism

Care about how others look at you

"I have to hide my emotions & my flaws"

Focus on fears & give up

"I'd rather quit than make a mistake/fail"

Defensive when getting feedback"

"Do you think that you can do better?"

Do you judge yourself based on what you see on others?

When you want to feel better about yourself you undermine others?

When you see others doing "better" you tend to feel "inferior"?

You frequently think about the things you lack and others have?

Strategies

From Over Thinking to Mindfulness

Pay attention to your inner critic.

Connect with breath & the present

Pretend you are supportive friend.

Give advice to your Inner Critic.

Stop Perfectionism

Practice Kindness

Be gentle & understanding with you

Connect with trust

Oxytocin

Comfort Yourself



- Drink a warm tea, take hot bath or massage
- Play soothing music
- Meditate
- Talk to a trusting friend
- Get physical affection from trusted people (or pets)
- Pray or repeat phrases that bring you comfort
- Gratitude on the spot

Reduce Social Comparison

Work on acceptance

Common humanity

Face challenges with what you have

Focus on your resources & strengths!

Common Humanity

- Everyone wants to be happy
- Everyone has to deal with challenges, change & pain
- Everyone makes mistakes, has flaws and act irrationally
- Everyone has their own suffering

From Suffering To Acceptance

Stop, observe your pain & breathe:

"I'm struggling in this moment & it's ok"

Observe your suffering:

"I'm not alone. Others are also suffering like me."

Ask your heart:

"What do I need right now?"

Offer compassion & acceptance:

"I choose to be kind to myself in this moment.
